Workshop takes place in performance space

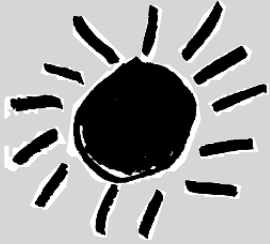
School should provide as many hand drums as possible (i.e. conga, bongo, djembe, etc.)
