Performance Requirements

Provisions:

1 reserved parking space (if parking is limited)

A private changing area with mirror and sink and safekeeping of Ms. Estabrook's personal belongings

Performance Space:

Classroom or library is the best setting

Students should be seated by performance time.

Ms. Estabrook should have ample space to move among the students.

Other:

Please hang a sign on the door during the performance to prevent interruptions.

Please ask school to refrain from fire drills, class bells and P.A. announcements if possible.

NOTE: The term "Indian" is used within the historical context of the story.

Grade 3-6: 25 student s maximum (one classroom at a time)

Grades 7-12: 80 students maximum

Performance length: 1 hour

Arrival time before first performance: 30 minutes

Time needed between performances: at least 10 minutes*

*If more than one character has been scheduled, 30 minutes to an hour is needed between performances.

Adult supervision is required.

Teacher participation is expected.
