Performance Requirements

Provisions:

1 reserved parking space (if parking is limited)

A private changing area with mirror and sink and safekeeping of Ms. Estabrook's personal belongings
Ms. Estabrook will need to confer with an attending teacher, before the program starts, about the entrance of the first mill girl.

Performance Space:

Classroom or library is the best setting
Students should be seated by performance time
Electrical outlet
Small table

Other:

Ms. Estabrook should have ample space to move among the students.
Please hang sign on door during performance to prevent interruption.
Please ask school to refrain from fire drills, class bells and P.A. announcements, if possible.
NOTE: Ms. Estabrook will bring a boom box with her.

Grade Levels: Grade 7-12

Audience Limit: 80 students

Performance length: 1 hour 20 minutes (cannot be shortened)

Arrival time before first performance: 1 hour

Strike time: 30 minutes

Time needed between performances: 30 minutes*

*If more than one character has been scheduled, 30minutes to an hour is needed between performances.

Adult supervision is required.

Teacher participation is expected.
