Performance Requirements

Provisions:

1 reserved parking space

A private area for changing and keeping personal belongings

Bottled water

Performance space:

A large classroom or library area (not an auditorium) with ample room for the artist to move freely in her bulky costumes.

Audience should be seated on the floor at the beginning of the performance in a horse-shoe format large enough to allow three people across the middle.

Because no sound system is used, please ensure that the space will allow for each student to hear.

Grade levels: K-2

Audience limits: 80

Performance length: 45 minutes including Q & A

(Time modifications may be made with prior notice to YA.)

Arrival before first performance: 20 minutes

Strike time: 5 minutes

Time needed between performances: 5 minutes

TEACHERS ARE EXPECTED TO MODEL PROPER AUDIENCE BEHAVIOR FOR STUDENTS!
