Student Workshop: Available with Jazz: America's Music from New Orleans to New York Performances

Workshop Description

Made in the Shade members teach students in the school jazz ensemble or concert band about the many elements of jazz, including riffing, dynamics, phrasing, call and response, and time and feel. The members will also demonstrate the differences in jazz styles, teach students how to swing, and introduce jazz improvisation.

Grade levels: 6-12

Participant Limit: 30

Workshop length: 45 minutes

Set-up time: 10 minutes (one musician) or 20 minutes (five musicians)

Time needed between workshops: 5 minutes

Workshop Requirements

10' X 15' space

Students must provide their own instruments.

Pre-Workshop Requirements

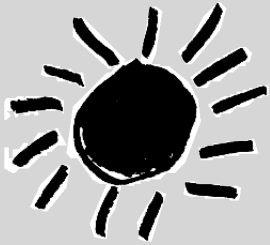
Artists will contact teachers before the workshop.
