Mass Movement:

Figurative Language Workshop

In this workshop, students learn to distinguish between the concepts of abstraction, similes and metaphor. They then discover how to articulate these concepts in both language and movement. By the end of the workshop they will be able to create a sequence of gestures or phrases using each of these concepts.

Workshop Requirements

Provisions:

One reserved parking space (for each artist)
Dressing area or lavatory near workshop space
CD player & Tape Deck (for each artist)
Water.

Performance Space

Smooth, non-splintered, and wooden floor space with plenty of room for movement.

Participants limit: 30

Participants are encouraged to dance barefoot.

Workshop length: 45- 60 minutes

Arrival time before first event: 20 minutes

Strike time: 15 minutes

A teacher or aide must be present during the workshop unless the teaching artist indicates this is not necessary.
