Pre-Workshop Requirements

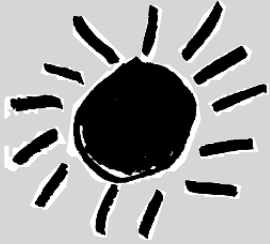
Artists will contact teachers before the workshop.
